**What We Are Doing in Our Little Town . . . God's Will can be imposed on our goliaths only by faith . . . faith= the word= God!"** The Lord's prayer says : Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven!

Matthew 26:38-39 NIV <sup>38</sup> Then he said to them, "My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me." <sup>39</sup> Going a little farther, he fell with his face to the ground and prayed, "**My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from me. Yet not as I will, but as you will.**"

**I. David and Goliath : Goliath . . The Obstacles . . The Philistia . . The Mountain . . The 'I No Can!' Goliath: 7'-10' tall, Enormous, Ugly, Impossible, Death, Run, hide, fear and trembling! Cost too much! 'What if I fail?'**

**II. David: 4'10" to 5'; You = a humble believer in the living God! Maybe too young or too inexperienced or too old and concerned, etc., etc., etc. Everyday believer in the power of God's will!"**

**III. Goliath Starts To Impose His Will On The Israeli Army!** I Samuel 17:8-10 NIV <sup>8</sup>Goliath stood and shouted to the ranks of Israel, "...Choose a man and have him come down to me. <sup>9</sup>If he is able to fight and kill me, we will become your subjects; but if I overcome him and kill him, you will become our subjects and serve us." <sup>10</sup>Then the Philistine said, "This day I defy the armies of Israel! Give me a man and let us fight each other."

**IV. The Soldiers and The King** I Samuel 17:11 NIV On hearing the Philistine's words, Saul and all the Israelites were dismayed and terrified.

**V. Goliath Tries to Impose His Will on David** I Samuel 17:43-44 NIV <sup>43</sup>He said to David, "Am I a dog, that you come at me with sticks?" And the Philistine cursed David by his gods. <sup>44</sup>"Come here," he said, "and I'll give your flesh to the birds and the wild animals!"

**VI. David Imposes God's Will Over His Goliath** I Samuel 17:45-47 NIV <sup>45</sup>David said to the Philistine, "You come against me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you in "the name of the Lord Almighty", "the God of the armies of Israel", "whom you have defied." [Genesis 12:3] <sup>46</sup>This day the Lord will deliver you into my hands, and I'll strike you down and cut off your head. ...<sup>47</sup>All those gathered here will know that it is not by sword or spear that the Lord saves; for the battle is the Lord's, and he will give all of you into our hands."

**VII. Action! Engage!** I Samuel 17:48-50 NIV <sup>48</sup>As the Philistine moved closer to attack him, David ran quickly toward the battle line to meet him. <sup>49</sup>Reaching into his bag and taking out a stone, he slung it and struck the Philistine on the forehead. The stone sank into his forehead, and he fell facedown on the ground. <sup>50</sup>So David triumphed over the Philistine with a sling and a stone; without a sword in his hand he struck down the Philistine and killed him.  
**[ God has made the stones easy for us = the cards]**

**VIII. This is what we are doing, 5 little cards at a time!**

**A small church on a small island with a bunch of believers in the living God can do to our goliaths!! Taking the word of God to our neighbors during a pandemic; no tv station, no radio station, not mega church and it's money. Giving Jesus to people in our home town. Juice from the mango . . . Milk from the coconut!**
