JOHN 1:1-4 NIV ¹ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ²He was with God in the beginning.³Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. ⁴In him was life, **and that life was the light of all mankind.**

FROM THE PROPHET JEREMIAH 31:31-34 NIV ³¹ “The days are coming,” declares the Lord, “when I will make a **new covenant** with the people of Israel and with the people of Judah. ³²It will not be like the covenant I made with their ancestors when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt, because they broke my covenant, though I was a husband to them,” declares the Lord.

FROM THE PROPHET ISAIAH 7:14 NIV ¹⁴ Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel.

Note: JESUS = “GOD SAVES!” EMMANUEL = “GOD WITH US!”

JOHN 3:16 NASB For God so loved the world, that he gave his **Only Begotten Son**, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

FROM THE ANGEL GABRIEL TO MARY: LUKE 1:30-33 NIV ³⁰ ... “Do not be afraid, Mary; you have found favor with God. ³¹You will conceive and give birth to a son, and **you are to call him Jesus**. ³²He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High.

TO JOSEPH: MATTHEW 1:20-21 NIV ²⁰ ... “Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the **Holy Spirit**. ²¹She will give birth to a son, and **you are to give him the name Jesus**,^[a] because he will **“Save his people from their sins.”**

FROM GOD THE FATHER: PHILIPPIANS 2:9-11 NKJV ⁹ Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him **the name which is above every name**, ¹⁰that **at the name of Jesus every knee should bow**, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, ¹¹and **that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord**, to the glory of God the Father.

FROM JOHN THE BAPTIST: JOHN 1:29 NASB The next day he **saw* Jesus coming to him and **said*, **“Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!**

FROM JESUS HIMSELF: JOHN 14:6 NIV Jesus answered, “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father **except through me**.

JOHN 10:10 NIV The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; **I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.**

FROM APOSTLE PETER MATTHEW 16:15-17 NIV ¹⁵ “But what about you?” he asked. “Who do you say I am?” ¹⁶Simon Peter answered, **“You are the Messiah, the Son of the Living God!”**

FROM THE SONG: Come Thou Long Expected Jesus : “Born a child and yet a King!”

FROM THE MAGI ;THE WISEMEN : MATTHEW 2:10-11NIV ¹⁰ When they saw the star, they were overjoyed. ¹¹On coming to the house, they saw the child with his mother Mary, and **they bowed down and**

worshiped him. Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts of Gold, Frankincense and Myrrh.

**Gold = Jesus "King of Kings and Lord of Lords!" Frankincense = Jesus divinity; to be worshiped
Myrrh = Jesus death**

JOHN SAYS: REVELATION 1:7-8 NIV ⁷ "Look, he is coming with the clouds," and "every eye will see him, even those who pierced him"; and all peoples on earth "will mourn because of him." So shall it be! Amen.

⁸ **"I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "who is, and who was, and who is to come, the Almighty."**

¹² "Look, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to each person according to what they have done. ¹³ **I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End. REVELATION 22:12-13 NIV**

REVELATION 19:11, 13, 16 NIV ¹¹ I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice he judges and wages war. ¹³ He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and **His Name is the Word of God.** ¹⁶ On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written: **King of kings and Lord of lords.**
