

## **LOVE GOD, LOVE OTHERS – Kahu Billy Mitchell Dec.27.2020**

**Mark 12: 29-31 NIV** <sup>29</sup>“The most important one,” answered Jesus, “is this: ‘Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. <sup>30</sup>Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.’ <sup>31</sup>The second is this: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ There is no commandment greater than these.”

**1. Love God! Mark 12:30 NIV** <sup>30</sup>Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.’

**My goal is God Himself, not joy, not peace, nor even blessing, but Himself, my God!**

**Jeremiah 29:13 NIV** <sup>13</sup>You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.

**Warnings from God: not to forget him! Revelation 2:2-5 NIV** <sup>2</sup>I know your deeds, your hard work and your perseverance. I know that you cannot tolerate wicked people, that you have tested those who claim to be apostles but are not, and have found them false. <sup>3</sup>You have persevered and have endured hardships for my name, and have not grown weary. <sup>4</sup>Yet I hold this against you: **You have forsaken the love you had at first.** <sup>5</sup>Consider how far you have fallen! **Repent and do the things you did at first. If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place.**

**Deuteronomy 8:11-14 NIV** <sup>11</sup>Be careful that you do not forget the Lord your God, failing to observe his commands, his laws and his decrees that I am giving you this day. <sup>12</sup>Otherwise, when you eat and are satisfied, when you build fine houses and settle down,<sup>13</sup>and when your herds and flocks grow large and your silver and gold increase and all you have is multiplied, <sup>14</sup>then your heart will become proud and you will forget the Lord your God, who brought you out of [YOUR] Egypt, out of the land [YOUR TIME] of slavery.

**Jeremiah 2:32 NIV** Does a young woman forget her jewelry, a bride her wedding ornaments? Yet my people have forgotten me, days without number.

**Prevention from forgetting God! DEUTERONOMY 6:6-9** <sup>6</sup>These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. <sup>7</sup>Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. <sup>8</sup>Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. <sup>9</sup>Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.

**Result of loving God ROMANS 8:28 NIV** <sup>28</sup>And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

**PSALM 5:11 NIV** But let all who take refuge in you be glad; let them ever sing for joy. Spread your protection over them, that those who love your name may rejoice in you.

**2. Love Others Mark 12:31 NIV** <sup>31</sup>The second is this: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ <sup>32</sup>There is no commandment greater than these.”

**Philippians 2:3 NIV** <sup>3</sup>Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves,
