Some say: John 1:1; 3:16; 10:10 NIV It may not be a scripture yet! Life? Song? But as for me... in the garden of his crushing!

<u>Matthew 26:38-39 NLT</u> <sup>38</sup> He told them, "My soul is crushed with grief to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me." <sup>39</sup> He went on a little farther and bowed with his face to the ground, praying, "My Father! If it is possible, let this cup of suffering be taken away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine." The Power of Talking to the Father!

Matthew 26: 61-64, 67-68 NIV

61 "This fellow said, 'I am able to destroy the temple of God and rebuild it in three days." 62 Then the high priest stood up and said to Jesus, "Are you not going to answer? What is this testimony that these men are bringing against you?" 63 But Jesus remained "Silent!". The high priest said to him, "I charge you under oath by the living God: Tell us if "You are the Messiah, the Son of God." 64 "You have said so," Jesus replied. "But I say to all of you: "From now on you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven." ... 67 Then they spit in his face and struck him with their fists. Others slapped him 68 and said, "Prophesy to us, Messiah. Who hit you?"

**STEPHEN:** Acts 7:55-56 NIV 55 But Stephen, full of the Holy Spirit, looked up to heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God. 56 "Look," he said, "I see heaven open and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God."

<u>Isaiah 53:7 NASB</u> He was oppressed and He was afflicted, **Yet He did not open His mouth**; Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, And like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, **So He did not open His mouth**.

ON THE CROSS! <u>Isaiah 53:5-6 NLT</u> But he was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was beaten so we could be whole.
