Some say : John 1:1 ; 3:16 ; 10:10 NIV It may not be a scripture yet! Life? Song?

Matthew 26:38-39 NLT ³⁸ He told them, "My soul is crushed with grief to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me."³⁹ He went on a little farther and bowed with his face to the ground, praying, "My Father! If it is possible, let this cup of suffering be taken away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine." The Power of Talking to the Father!

DURING HIS TRIALS: SILENCE! :The same silence with the woman caught in adultery

Matthew 26: 61-64, 67-68 NIV ⁶¹ "This fellow said, 'I am able to destroy the temple of God and rebuild it in three days.' "⁶² Then the high priest stood up and said to Jesus, "Are you not going to answer? What is this testimony that these men are bringing against you?" ⁶³ **But Jesus remained "Silent!"**. The high priest said to him, "I charge you under oath by the living God: Tell us if **"You are the Messiah, the Son of God."**⁶⁴ "You have said so," Jesus replied. "But I say to all of you: **"From now on you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven."** ...⁶⁷ Then they spit in his face and struck him with their fists. Others slapped him ⁶⁸ and said, **"Prophecy to us, Messiah. Who hit you?"**

STEPHEN: Acts 7:55-56 NIV ⁵⁵ But Stephen, full of the Holy Spirit, looked up to heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God. ⁵⁶ "Look," he said, "I see heaven open and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God."

Isaiah 53:7 NASB He was oppressed and He was afflicted, **Yet He did not open His mouth;** Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, And like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, **So He did not open His mouth.**

ON THE CROSS! Isaiah 53:5-6 NLT But he was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed. ⁶ All of us, like sheep, have strayed away. We have left God's paths to follow our own. Yet the Lord laid on him the sins of us all.

COMMUNION : I Corinthians 11:24b, 25b NKJV ²⁴ . . . "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me." ²⁵ . . . "This cup is the new Covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink *it*, in remembrance of Me."

THE THIEF ON THE CROSS: Luke 23:42b-43 NIV ⁴² . . . "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom. ⁴³ Jesus answered him, "Truly I tell you, today you will be with me in paradise."

LAWA!
