Therefore ... perhaps He will <u>ho'omāmā - lighten</u> His hand from you, from your gods, and from your land. 1 Samuel 6: 5a, c NKJV

**Believing in God vs. Belonging to God -** Ray Flores October 26, 2025 Many acknowledge God exists — but believing *in* God is not the same as *belonging to* Him.

<u>Iames 2:19 NIV</u> You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that — and shudder. Belief acknowledges God's existence. Belonging submits to His Lordship. Our truth must come from one source — the Holy Bible, the living Word of God.

<u>2 Timothy 3:16 NIV</u> All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, God's Word does not change to fit the culture; culture must conform to His Word.

<u>Isaiah 40:8 NIV</u> The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of our God endures forever.

- **Point 1: Belonging to God Is Relational** *John 14:15 NIV* "If you love me, keep my commands." Belief recognizes that God exists; belonging walks daily in obedience to His Word.
- <u>Iohn 8:31b NIV</u> ... "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples." Belief stays in your head; following flows from your heart. Belief says, "God is real." Following says, "God is in control of my life." <u>Psalm 119:105 NIV</u> Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.
- A. Prayer Relationship with God Prayer is our lifeline to God. <u>Luke 5:16 NIV</u> But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed. Through prayer we listen, surrender, and align our hearts with God's will. <u>Philippians 4:6c, 7a,c NIV</u> ... by prayer and petition ... the peace of God ... will guard your hearts and your minds ...
- **B. Obeying His Word** Belonging means following His voice through Scripture. <u>Psalm 1:2a, 3a</u> <u>NIV</u> . . . whose delight is in the law of the LORD . . . That person is like a tree planted by streams of water.
- C. Relationship Before Religion Religion without relationship leads to emptiness. *John 15:4a,* 5c NIV "Remain in me, as I also remain in you. . . . apart from me you can do nothing."
- Point 2: Obedience The Proof of Belonging <u>Luke 9:23b NIV</u> "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me."
- **A. Faith Produces Obedience** Faith without obedience is dead. <u>James 2:17 NIV</u> Faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead. <u>John 14:21a NIV</u> "Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me."
- **B. Daily Surrender** Following is a daily decision to surrender our will. *Romans* 12:1b NIV ... offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God this is your true and proper worship.
- **C. Obedience Flows from Relationship** True obedience is love in action. *1 Samuel 15:22c NIV* . . . . *To obey is better than sacrifice,* . . .
- D. Obedience Brings Blessing <u>Deuteronomy 28:1a, 2a NIV</u> If you fully obey the Lord ... all these blessings will come on you ...
- **E. Daily Cross, Daily Choice** Will I follow my feelings or His Word? Will I follow culture or Christ?

- **Point 3: Following God Transforms You** *Romans 12:2a NIV Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind*. Believing informs the mind; following transforms the life.
- A. Transformed by Christ <u>2 Corinthians 5:17 NIV</u> ... if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! <u>Philippians 1:6b NIV</u> ... he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion ...
- **B.** Evidence of True Faith A transformed life shows fruit of genuine belief. <u>John 10:27–28a NIV</u> "My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life . . ."
- Point 4: Warning Out of Love <u>Matthew 7:21a NIV</u> "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven..." Belief without obedience can produce false security.
- A. Belief Alone Cannot Save <u>James 2:19b, 20b NIV</u> Even the demons believe that—and shudder... faith without deeds is useless?
- B. Belonging Brings Eternal Reward <u>Matthew 25:21b,d NIV</u> ... "Well done, good and faithful servant... Come and share your master's happiness!"
- C. Love and Loyalty <u>John 14:23b NIV</u> ... "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them ..."
- D. Eternal Reward <u>Revelation 22:12a-b, 13a NIV</u> "Look, I am coming soon! My reward is with me... I am the Alpha and the Omega..."

Conclusion: Belief vs. Belonging Belief acknowledges God's existence; belonging surrenders to His Lordship. Belief informs; following transforms. Belief may impress people; following pleases God. Belief may be temporary; belonging produces eternal fruit.

<u>John 10:27-28a NIV</u> "My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life . . . "
