**Romans 12:3-6 NIV** <sup>3</sup> For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you. <sup>4</sup> For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, <sup>5</sup> so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. <sup>6</sup> We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us.

Different Gifts: If your gift is Prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith;

**1 Thessalonians 5:19-22 NIV** <sup>19</sup> Do not quench the Spirit. <sup>20</sup> Do not treat prophecies with contempt <sup>21</sup> but test them all; hold on to what is good, <sup>22</sup> reject every kind of evil.

**Joel 2:28 NIV** "And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions.

Romans 12:7a NIV if it is Serving, then serve . . .

**1 Peter 4:10 NIV** Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms.

**Colossians 3:23-24 NIV** <sup>23</sup> Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, <sup>24</sup> since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.

Romans 12:7b NIV . . . if it is Teaching, then teach;

**Matthew 28:19-20 NIV** <sup>19</sup> Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

**2 Timothy 3:16-17 NIV** <sup>16</sup> All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, <sup>17</sup> so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Romans 12:8a NIV if it is to Encourage, then give encouragement;

**Joshua 1:9 NIV** Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

**Deuteronomy 31:8 NIV** The Lord himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged."

**Matthew 11:28-30 NIV** <sup>28</sup> "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup> Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup> For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

Romans 12:8b NIV if it is Giving, then give generously;

**Luke 6:38 NIV** Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."

**2 Corinthians 9:6 NIV** Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.

**Malachi 3:10 NIV** Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it.

**Romans 12:8c NIV** if it is to <u>Lead</u>, do it diligently;

**Psalm 31:3 NIV** Since you are my rock and my fortress, for the sake of your name lead and guide me.

**Ephesians 6:1-4 NIV** <sup>1</sup> Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. <sup>2</sup> "Honor your father and mother"---which is the first commandment with a promise--- <sup>3</sup> "so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth." <sup>4</sup> Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.

Romans 12:8d NIV . . . if it is to show Mercy, do it cheerfully. ...

**Matthew 5:7 NIV** Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.

**Luke 6:36 NIV** Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful.

**Zechariah 7:9 NIV** "This is what the Lord Almighty said: 'Administer true justice; show mercy and compassion to one another.
