PULE: Father you are the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. You will not grow tired or weary, and your understanding no one can fathom. <u>I THESSALONIANS 5:15-18 NIV</u> ¹⁵ Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always strive to do what is good for each other and for everyone else. ¹⁶ Rejoice always, ¹⁷ pray continually, ¹⁸ give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

<u>PSALM 100:1-5 NIV</u> ¹Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth. ²Worship the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. ³Know that the Lord is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture.⁴Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name.⁵ For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations.

Give thanks before your need is met; while it is being met; and after God has met your need!

PHILIPPIANS 4:4-9 NASB (our friend at the airport!) (quote on the board on church in Palo Alto) ("When we give God thanks in advance joy is released!") ⁴Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice! ⁵Let your gentle *spirit* be known to all people. The Lord is near. ⁶Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and pleading 'With Thanksgiving' let your requests be made known to God. ⁷And the peace of God, which surpasses all Gomprehension, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. ⁸Finally, brothers *and sisters*, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence and if anything worthy of praise, think about these things. ⁹As for the things you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, practice these things, and the God of peace will be with you.
