- **I. DRAW NEARER TO GOD!** <u>James 4:8 NIV</u> Come near to God and he will come near to you.
  - **1. It Is Finished** <u>John 19:30 NIV</u> When he had received the drink, Jesus said, "**It is finished.**" With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.
  - 2. Receive Jesus Into Your Intimate Life . . . He Will Not Discourage You

    Luke 18:35-43 NIV 35 As Jesus approached Jericho, a blind man was sitting by the roadside begging. 36 When he heard the crowd going by, he asked what was happening. 37 They told him, "Jesus of Nazareth is passing by." 38 He called out, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" Those who led the way rebuked him and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!"
  - $^{40}$  Jesus stopped and ordered the man to be brought to him. When he came near, Jesus asked him,  $^{41}$  "What do you want me to do for you?"
  - "Lord, I want to see," he replied. <sup>42</sup> Jesus said to him, "Receive your sight; your faith has healed you." <sup>43</sup> Immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus, praising God. **When all the people saw it, they also praised God.**

    Joshua 24:14a & 15 NIV
