<u>Philippians 2:10-11 NASB</u> ¹⁰ so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and *that* every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

In The Name of Jesus Christ Means ... By The Authority of Jesus Christ. Da man himself

<u>Matthew 28:18 NIV</u> Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me."

By The Authority of Jesus Christ

- The devil was powerless because of his name

Luke 10:17 NIV The seventy-two returned with joy and said, "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name."

- The demons were cast out in his name

<u>Mark 16:17-18 NIV</u> ¹⁷ And these signs will accompany those who believe: **In my name** they will drive out demons; they will **speak in new tongues;** ¹⁸ they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well." **Healing occurred in his name** [Acts 3:6, 3:16]

<u>Acts 4:10 NIV</u> then know this, you and all the people of Israel: <u>It is by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth</u>, whom you crucified but whom God raised from the dead, that this man stands before you healed.

- Salvation comes in his name (Rom. 10:13)

<u>Acts 4:12 NIV</u> Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.

- We are to baptize in his name

<u>Matthew 28:19 NIV</u> Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

- We are justified in his name

<u>1 Corinthians 6:11b NIV</u> But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.

- Everything we do and say is done in His name

<u>Colossians 3:17 NIV</u> And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, <u>do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus</u>, giving thanks to God the Father <u>through him</u>.

It's Praying in Jesus' Name Jesus invites, encourages and commands us to pray in his name.

<u>Philippians 4:6-7 NIV</u> ⁶ Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

James 5:16b NIV The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

Peter Heals a Lame Beggar Acts 3:1-5 NIV

¹ One day Peter and John were going up to the temple at the time of prayer—at three in the afternoon.² Now a man who was lame from birth was being carried to the temple gate called Beautiful, where he was put every day to beg from those going into the temple courts. ³ When he saw Peter and John about to enter, <u>he</u> <u>asked them for money</u>. ⁴ Peter looked straight at him, as did John. Then Peter said, <u>"Look at us!"</u> ⁵ So the man gave them his attention, expecting to get something from them.

Acts 3:6 NKJV Then Peter said, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk."

<u>Notes:</u> This man asked for money, but Peter gave him something much better - greater then money-he gave him the use of his legs. Something that all the money in the world couldn't do . . . You see, sometimes we settle for what the world offers (human nature, the norm) rather than what the Spirit of Christ has to offer for us. (The Spiritual Realm.)

Luke 18:27 NIV Jesus replied, "What is impossible with man is possible with God."

<u>Notes:</u> Sometimes we don't even think about asking God for help in our situation or crisis. God wants to give us a whole new life and help for *all* our problems. God has something better for us." Ask God for what you want, but don't be surprised when he gives you what you really need.
