Ephesians 3:16-21 NIV ¹⁶ I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, ¹⁸ may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, <u>to grasp how wide</u> <u>and long and high and deep is the love of Christ</u>, ¹⁹ and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the <u>fullness of God</u>. ²⁰ Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, ²¹ to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.

<u>Notes:</u> God's love is total. It reaches every corner of our experience. God's love is wide—it covers the extent of our own experience, and it reaches out to the whole world. God's love is long—it extends throughout our lives and into eternity. God's love is high—it rises to the heights of our celebration and elation. God's love is deep—it reaches to the depths of discouragement, despair, and even death. When you feel shut out or isolated, remember that you can never be lost to <u>God's love.</u>

To be filled with the fullness of God is to be conscious of and yielded to God's: 1. Presence, 2. Strength, 3. Care for others, 4. Spiritual Authority, 5. Moral Excellence 6. Character (holiness, righteousness, love).

1. God's Presence Isaiah 41:10 NIV
 So <u>do not fear</u>, for I am with you; <u>do not be dismayed</u>, for I am your

 God. I will <u>strengthen</u> you and <u>help</u> you; I will <u>uphold</u> you with my righteous right hand.

 Exodus 33:14 NIV
 The Lord replied, <u>"My Presence will go with you,</u> and I will give you <u>rest."</u>

2. God's Strength Psalm 73:26 NIV My flesh and my heart may fail, but <u>God is the strength of my heart</u> and my portion forever.

<u>Psalm 28:7 NIV</u> The Lord is <u>my strength</u> and <u>my shield</u>; my <u>heart trusts in him</u>, and <u>he helps me</u>. My heart leaps for joy, and with <u>my song I praise him</u>.

3. God's Care For Others <u>1 Peter 5:6-7 NIV</u> ⁶ <u>Humble yourselves</u>, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time ⁷ <u>Cast all your anxiety</u> on him because <u>he cares for you</u>. <u>Isaiah 46:4 NIV</u> Even to your old age and gray hairs I am he, I am he who will <u>sustain you</u>. I have made you and I will carry you; I will sustain you and I will rescue you.

4. Spiritual Authority <u>John 16:13 NIV</u> But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, <u>he will guide you into all</u> <u>the truth.</u> He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and <u>he will tell you what is yet to</u> <u>come.</u>

Luke 10:19 *NIV* I have given you <u>authority</u> to trample on snakes and scorpions and to <u>overcome all the</u> <u>power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.</u>

Ephesians 6:12-14a NIV ¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but **against the** <u>rulers</u>, against the <u>authorities</u>, against the <u>powers of this dark world</u> and against the <u>spiritual forces of evil in the</u> <u>heavenly realms</u>. ¹³ Therefore put on the <u>full armor of God</u>, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to <u>stand your ground</u>, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then ...

5. Moral Excellence <u>2 Peter 1:3 NIV</u> *His divine power has given us* <u>*everything*</u> *we need for a godly life through our* <u>*knowledge*</u> *of him who called us by his own glory and goodness.*

<u>2 Peter 1:5-7 NIV</u> ⁵ For this very reason, make every effort to <u>add to your faith goodness</u>; and to goodness, <u>knowledge</u>; ^s and to knowledge, <u>self-control</u>; and to self-control, <u>perseverance</u>; and to perseverance, <u>godliness</u>;⁷ and to godliness, <u>mutual affection</u>; and to mutual affection, <u>love</u>.

6. Godly Character <u>Philippians 2:3-5 NIV</u> ³ Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves⁴ not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. ⁵ In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:

Some Characteristics of Godly Character include:

- **Respect for God's word:** Living life with deep respect for and obedience to God's word
- Trust in God: Trusting God completely and surrendering to his will and leadership
- Endurance: The ability to withstand prolonged hardship or adversity
- Free Will: The freedom to decide without undue pressure whether to embrace or reject a particular course of action
- **Unselfishness:** Being happy to give time, money, food, or kindness to people
- Self-sacrifice: Being willing to sacrifice your own needs and comfort for the good of another
