

**2 Thrones of Judgement #1- The Great White Throne** Revelation 20:11-15 NIV

<sup>11</sup>Then I saw a **great white throne** and him who was seated on it. The earth and the heavens fled from his presence, and there was no place for them. <sup>12</sup>And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life. The dead were judged according to what they had done as recorded in the books. <sup>13</sup>The sea gave up the dead that were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead that were in them, and each person was judged according to what they had done. <sup>14</sup>Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. The lake of fire is the second death. <sup>15</sup>Anyone whose name was not found written in **the book of life** was thrown into the lake of fire.

**The Good News for the Believer #2 - The Judgement Seat of Jesus Christ**

2 Corinthians 5:6-10 <sup>6</sup>Therefore we are always confident and know that as long as we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord. <sup>7</sup>For we live by faith, not by sight. <sup>8</sup>We are confident, I say, and would prefer to be away from the body and at home with the Lord. <sup>9</sup>**So we make it our goal to please him**, whether we are at home in the body or away from it. <sup>10</sup>For we must all appear before **the judgment seat of Christ, so that each of us may receive what is (due us ) for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad.**

**The Good Report and The Good Life . . . Two Main Points in One Commandment**

**The Greatest Commandment** Mark 12:29-31 NIV <sup>29</sup>"The most important one," answered Jesus, "is this: 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. <sup>30</sup>Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. <sup>31</sup>The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no commandment greater than these."

**1. Love the Lord Thy God . . .** Mark 12:30 NIV <sup>30</sup>Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.<sup>31</sup>  
Jeremiah 29:13 NIV <sup>13</sup>You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.

Notes for Revelation 14:4 NIV "to remain spiritually pure means to resist the seductions and idolatries of the present world— power, wealth, and sexual immorality. To do so requires daily application of God's word, for it has a purifying effect on the mind and heart. It requires great resolution to live for Christ and not give in to these temptations. (notes are from NIV Life Application Study Bible.)

Notes for Psalm 89:15-18 NIV Happy are those who so know the joyful sound of the gospel as to obey it; who experience its power upon their hearts, and bring forth the fruit of it in their lives. Though believers are nothing in themselves, yet having all in Christ Jesus, they may rejoice in his name. May the Lord enable us to do so. The joy of the Lord is the strength of his people; whereas unbelief dispirits ourselves and discourages others. Though it steals upon us under a semblance of humility, yet it is the very essence of pride. Christ is the Holy One of Israel; and in him was that peculiar people more blessed than in any other blessing. . (from Matthew Henry)

James 1:22 NIV <sup>22</sup>Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.

**2. Love Your Neighbor as Yourself . . .** Mark 12:31 NIV The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no commandment greater than these."

Matthew 25:37-40 NIV <sup>37</sup>"Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink?'<sup>38</sup>When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? <sup>39</sup>When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?'<sup>40</sup>"The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.'
