1. Jesus's Love For His Father And Us! . . . For His Father

Luke 22:42 NIV "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done."

2. For me and you...

John 3:16 NIV For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

5 Points:

1. He lived John 14:19 NIV Before long, the world will not see me anymore, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live.

John 14:15-18 NIV ¹⁵ "If you love me, keep my commands. ¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever— ¹⁷the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you. ¹⁸ I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.

Notes: The Advocate, Comforter, Encourager or Counselor, The Holy Spirit of God himself—would come after Jesus was gone to comfort, encourage, guide, and intercede for us. The Holy Spirit is the very presence of God within us and all believers, helping us live as God wants and building Christ's church on earth.

2. He Died Romans 5:8 NIV But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Notes: "While we were still sinners"— God sent Jesus Christ to die for us, not because we were good enough, but just because he loved us and wants us to spend eternity with him. He loved us even before we turned to him.

3. He Rose Matthew 28:6 NIV He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay.

Notes: Jesus' resurrection is the key to the Christian faith. Just as he promised, Jesus rose from the dead. The tomb is empty, He is not here, He is alive

4. He Intercedes Romans 8:34 NIV Who then is the one who condemns? No one. Christ Jesus who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us.

Notes: Jesus sits at the right hand of God interceding for us... -God will turn tragedy to triumph, poverty to riches, pain to glory, and defeat to victory.

5. He is coming back

1 Thessalonians 4:16-18 NIV ¹⁶ For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷ After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. ¹⁸ Therefore encourage one another with these words.

Romans 10:9-10 NIV – the sinner's prayer

Notes: All believers As Paul comforted the Thessalonians with the promise of the Resurrection, we should comfort and reassure each other with this great hope. When Christ returns, all believers—dead and alive—will be reunited, never to suffer or die again.
