## 4 Steps to Applying God's Word in Us

**1. Read & Study the Bible Hebrews 5:12-14 NIV** <sup>12</sup> In fact, though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. You need milk, not solid food! <sup>13</sup> Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness. <sup>14</sup> But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil.

**Proverbs 4:20-21 NIV** My son, pay attention to what I say; turn your ear to my words. [21] Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart;

**2. Memorize Deuteronomy 11:18 NIV** Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads.

**Proverbs 7:2-3 NIV** <sup>2</sup> Keep my commands and you will live; guard my teachings as the apple of your eye. <sup>3</sup> Bind them on your fingers; write them on the tablet of your heart.

**John 14:26 NIV** But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

**3. Meditate Joshua 1:8 NIV** Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.

**Matthew 13:23 NIV** But the seed falling on good soil refers to someone who hears the word and understands it. This is the one who produces a crop, yielding a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown."

**4. Applying God's Word James 1:25 NIV** But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do.

**James 1:22 NIV** Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.
