

## What is Dispensation?

For our purposes, it is a method of interpreting biblical history into different periods of time; a framework through which God relates to mankind. There are 7 distinct ages or dispensations in the Bible. Each dispensation (age) begins with an offer of blessing by God, and ends with failure by man to meet God's conditions and a resulting period of Divine judgment.

## The Age of Grace

The cross represents the greatest act of Grace. (2 Timothy 3:1-7 NASB1995) But realize this, that in the last days difficult times will come. For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, revilers, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy, unloving, irreconcilable, malicious gossips, without self-control, brutal, haters of good, treacherous, reckless, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, holding to a form of godliness, although they have denied its power; Avoid such men as these. For among them are those who enter into households and captivate weak women weighed down with sins, led on by various impulses, always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.

## Our Responsibility - Be Ready, Be Bold, Take Action!

The media is normalizing perversion. Be aware and do not conform. Speak and share God's absolute truth.

(Romans 12:2 NASB1995) And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

(Matthew 10:16 NASB1995) "Behold, I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves; so be shrewd as serpents and innocent as doves."
