II. Rolling Dialogue With a Shocked and Reluctant Moses!

GOD to Moses: Exodus 3:9-10 NIV ⁹And now the cry of the Israelites has reached me, and I have seen the way the Egyptians are oppressing them. ¹⁰ So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring my people the Israelites out of Egypt."

Moses: Exodus 3:11 NIV ..., "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?"

GOD: Exodus 3:12 NIV ... "I will be with you...."

Moses: "But what's your name?"

GOD: Exodus 3:14-15 NIV 14 ... "I am who I am ...—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob— ...

Moses: Exodus 4:1 NIV ... "What if they do not believe me or listen to me and say, "The Lord did not appear to you'?"

Moses: Exodus 4:10 NIV ... "Pardon your servant, Lord. I have never been eloquent ... I am slow of speech and tongue."

GOD: Exodus 4:11 NIV ... "Who gave human beings their mouths? ..."

Moses: Exodus 4:13 NIV ... "Pardon your servant, Lord. Please send someone else."

GOD: Exodus 4:14 NIV 14 Then the Lord's anger burned against Moses and he said, "What about your brother, Aaron the Levite?

GOD: Exodus 4:22-23 NIV ²² Then say to Pharaoh, 'This is what the Lord says: <u>Israel is my firstborn son, ²³ and I told you, "Let my son go, so he may worship me." But you refused to let him go; so I will kill your firstborn son."</u>

Moses: Exodus 5:1 ... "This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: 'Let my people go, so that they may hold a festival to me in the wilderness."

Pharaoh: Exodus 5:2 . . . "Who is the Lord, that I should obey him and let Israel go? I do not know the Lord and I will not let Israel go."

Pharaoh: Exodus 5:6-9 NIV 6 That same day Pharaoh gave this order ... 7 "You are no longer to supply the people with straw for making bricks; let them go and gather their own straw. 8 But require them to make the same number of bricks as before; don't reduce the quota ..."

The Israelite Overseers to Moses: Exodus 5:21 NIV ... "May the Lord look on you and judge you! You have made us obnoxious to Pharaoh and his officials and have put a sword in their hand to kill us."

Moses to GOD: Exodus 5:22-23 NIV ... "Why, Lord, why have you brought trouble on this people? Is this why you sent me? ²³ Ever since I went to Pharaoh to speak in your name, he has brought trouble on this people, and you have not rescued your people at all."

GOD: Exodus 6:6 NIV 6 "Therefore, say to the Israelites: 'I am the Lord, and I will bring you out from under the yoke of the Egyptians..."

Moses: Exodus 6:9 NIV 9 Moses reported this to the Israelites, but they did not listen to him because of their discouragement and harsh labor.

GOD: Exodus 6:11NIV ... 11 "Go, tell Pharaoh king of Egypt to let the Israelites go out of his country."

Moses: Exodus 6:12 NIV 12... If the Israelites will not listen to me, why would Pharaoh listen to me, since I speak with faltering lips?"
