MATTHEW 4:4 NIV Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, **but on every word that comes from the mouth of God."**

PSALM 46:10 NKJV "Be still, and know that I *am* God"; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!

PSALM 37:7 NIV Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for him; do not fret when people succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes.

EXODUS 14:14 NIV The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still."

JOB 6:24 NIV Teach me, and I will be quiet; show me where I have been wrong.

PSALM 62:5-6 NIV Yes, my soul, find rest in God; my hope comes from him. ⁶Truly he is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I will not be shaken.

PSALM 119:105 NIV

ISAIAH 3:17-18 NIV The fruit of that righteousness will be peace; its effect will be quietness and confidence forever. ¹⁸ My people will live in peaceful dwelling places, in secure homes, in undisturbed places of rest.

Three Prayers

1. THE LORD'S PRAYER – MATTHEW 6:9-13 KJV Our Father WHO art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. ¹⁰ Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. ¹¹ Give us this day our daily bread. ¹² And forgive us our TRESPASSES, as we forgive THOSE WHO TRESPASS AGAINST US. ¹³ And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

THE TWENTY THIRD PSALM KJV The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. ²He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. ³He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake. ⁴Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.⁵ Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over. ⁶ Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the Lord for ever.
